What is Sunday School? It is the STRONGEST ARM of Discipleship in the local church community today.

<u>What is Discipleship?</u> It is Jesus' expectation for his followers that we are "to become more and more like Himself." (Luke 6:40)

If you and your family are NOT currently involved and plugged in to a Sunday School small group, WE INVITE YOU to come. Here are Four (4) very biblical reasons for believers to have your own Sunday School small group:

- 1. A Community reason! Community was the practice of Jesus while He was on earth. If there is community in our Savior and Godhead, there should be community with believers, both large groups, and small groups. Community is important to God, and Sunday School is a great way for community to be built and strengthened.

We need each other as believers and as the Body of Christ. Sunday school is one very effective and proven way for us to practice the "one another's" we are taught in the New Testament.
- 4. <u>A Practical reason!</u> This one is obvious but often forgotten. <u>Sunday School is Church!</u> It is practical biblical church where ministry is accomplished, where spiritual growth occurs, and where everyone can be involved and serving. Through Sunday school everyone can exercise their God given spiritual gifts. Sunday school is a place where your spiritual gifts can be "unleashed" and used to edify the body of Christ.

Friends, if you are not currently plugged in to Sunday school, YOU ARE INVITED! All groups meet at 9:30am on Sunday mornings on the church campus. We are ready for you and your whole family!
